Memorial Day Facts

- Started on May 30, 1868
- Union General John A. Logan declared the day an occasion to decorate the graves of Civil War soldiers
- Twenty years later, the name was changed to Memorial Day
- President Richard M. Nixon declared Memorial Day a federal holiday in 1971



Ascension of the Lord

ASCENSION: the act of rising to a higher level

The Ascension of the Lord takes place forty days after the resurrection of Jesus (Easter). Technically, this day falls on a Thursday, but the celebration is transferred to the following Sunday. On the day, Jesus was taken up to Heaven in his resurrected body in the presence of his apostles.

BIBLICAL REFERENCES

While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. Luke 24:51

So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God. Mark 16:19

As the apostles were watching, Jesus was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. While he was going and they were gazing up toward heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." Acts 1:6-11

The ascension is also professed in the Nicene Creed and in the Apostles' Creed. "He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father..."

Jesus departs, he ascends to Heaven. His return to the Father. But this does not mean a separation, for he remains forever with us in a new way. By his ascension, the Risen Lord draws the gaze of the Apostles - and our gaze - to the heights of Heaven to show us that the end of our journey is the Father. Yet, Jesus remains present and active in the affairs of human history through the power and the gifts of his Spirit, for he dwells with us, even if we do not see him with our eyes. He is there! He accompanies us, he guides us, he takes us by the hand and leads us up where we belong. This Lord is with us! Pope Francis, June 1, 2014
