<u>SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION - Important Information - Please Read.</u>

- 1. Visitation does not award high school scholarships. You need to call the school your child is applying to see what they offer and the qualifications.
- 2. Please **examine the criteria carefully** to see if your child qualifies. Many are academic scholarships and awarded to students with high-standardized test scores and a specific grade point average.
- 3. If your child qualifies and needs letters of recommendation from teachers, priests, or principal, please submit the request in writing to each individual you are asking to write the recommendation letter. This should be done at least two weeks before the letter is needed. Please include the name of the high school as well as the name or type of scholarship for which you are applying. It is also helpful to include information regarding extra curricular clubs and activities, service projects, awards or honors both in school and out of school.
- 4. Unless told otherwise, the letters of recommendation are mailed directly to the high school. Please indicate in your written request, the date the letters are due into the high school and the name of a contact person.
